Referral Resources for Immigration Legal Issues

Non-citizens seeking legal assistance for Immigration related issues should first contact one of the following clinics, for an assessment screening. Following the screening, the clinic staff will refer the person to an appropriate agency for services meeting their need. Appropriate low-cost or no-cost immigration legal service referral resources will be provided for low-income persons, and a referral list of experienced private immigration attorneys will be provided to persons who do not qualify for the low-cost or no-cost agency services. Please contact the screening agencies to find out if you need to schedule an appointment.
