On Thursday, May 26, 2016, the City of Cambridge and the architect, William Rawn and Arrowstreet, will host a public meeting in the Community Room at the Millers River Apartments located at 15 Lambert Street from 6:30 – 8:00 pm as part of the community process for the King Open and Cambridge Street Upper School & Community Complex.

City staff, Architects, and the Construction Manager will be in attendance to provide an overview and update of the Schematic Design which has just been completed. Their presentation will include parking, student drop off, transportation flow around the building, landscaping design elements, building exterior finishes being considered, and an update for residents on the inclusion of the CPS Administration Offices as part of this project. New information regarding the construction schedule, specifically when the abatement and demolition activities will begin, shall also be provided. The City, Architects, and the Construction Manager look forward to listening to your comments on the project update.

Those attending may enter the Millers River Apartments via the Gore Street or Lambert Street entrances. If entering the building from Gore St., take a right, go past the library and laundry room, and the Community Room will be at the end of the hallway on the right. Entering from Lambert St., take a left, go past the library and the laundry room, and the Community Room will be at the end of the hallway on the right.
