Excitement is growing about our new school! I can't wait for students and families to see inside this spectacular, state-of-the-art facility.

We are in the midst of a very complex move process. By December 21-22, we will have moved two schools comprised of 70 classrooms, 100 faculty and staff, two libraries, two gyms, and nearly 600 students. The warmer weather has allowed crews to continue to work on the outdoor areas, which will soon feature an array of playground options including basketball hoops, climbing structures, and small practice field.

Although we will do our best to ensure everything goes smoothly, anyone who has gone through a household move knows that the unexpected can sometimes arise. As we work to resolve any problems that may occur, I want to thank you in advance for your patience and support.


Arrival & Dismissal

Each school has its own main door inside a courtyard facing Putnam Avenue. Visitors will ring the bell for the school they are visiting. From the lobby, PAUS will be to the left and MLK School will be to the right.

Families who drive to the school should look for parking on the side streets pictured below. Additionally, the curb on Kinnaird Street has been moved in to allow drivers to briefly pull aside without blocking traffic.

MLK School: During morning arrival, students will be dropped off in front of the building and enter through the Magee Street entrance. In the afternoon, walkers, bike riders, and students being driven will exit via the main entrance.

PAUS: In the morning, bus riders and students who eat breakfast or participate in morning gym activities may gain early entrance via Magee Street. Students who see their teachers in the morning should ring the bell at the main entrance to be admitted. Students who are driven, walk, or bike to school will enter and exit via the main entrance.



Drivers: Active drop-off can be found on Kinnaird Street. Look for parking on Putnam, Flagg, Callender, Hayes, Howard or Kinnaird.

In Case of Emergency
