What is Summer Academy?

Summer Academy is an intensive seven-week summer program for highly motivated, under-resourced high school juniors and seniors from the Boston area. We offer two levels of courses in college-level math and college-level English and writing. Each course is led by a college professor who will provide you with engaging instruction, dialogue and practice in core content areas.

Why You Should Attend

Participating in Summer Academy is a great way to prepare yourself the rigors of college. On average, students who participate see a 0.5 college GPA increase in calculus and 0.6 and 0.7 GPA increase in physics and engineering. You will be better able to compete at the nation's leading colleges and universities and complete a writing, premedical or STEM curriculum.

After you participate in Summer Academy you'll be eligible to apply to our scholarship program, which attempts to close the shortfalls between the amount of money you are offered in your financial package and the actual cost of your college education. We also offer college counseling, mentors, and assistance with summer internships. We are a support system for you during your college and graduate school career.
