Here are 5 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT SUMMER OPPORTUNITIES:

- 1. Summer is 10 weeks and is a good time for middle school youth to try new things and pursue new or existing interests and skills.
- 2. There are many quality summer opportunities available to all Cambridge youth inside and outside the city that are enriching, structured, and safe.
- 3. Many opportunities have deadlines and fill up quickly it is better to apply/register NOW and decide later than to wait. (Just let the program know if you are no longer considering it).
- 4. Some opportunities are free, and even those with a cost often have financial aid and scholarships money available just ask! (And we can help negotiate with some programs.)
- 5. In addition to your child's Advisor, each Upper School has people available to help you find and enroll in summer opportunities!
