


### What is Camp Kesem?









# Camp Kesem Summer 2017

## Camp Kesem 2016 at a Glance

- First camp founded in 2001 at Stanford University
- 2. 80+ total camps across the U.S.
- 3. Goal of 6000 campers
- 4. 3000+ volunteer college student leaders



## Camp Kesem MIT

The MIT chapter was founded in 2006, and we've been growing ever since. In 2016, we raised almost \$150,000 and welcomed 180 campers and 90 college student volunteers.

- 2:1 camper-to-counselor ratio.
- Fully planned and staffed by MIT students who are thoroughly trained before camp.
- Professional staff includes a nurse and therapist who stay onsite all week.
- Open to all families regardless of race, religion, nationality, or financial status. Camp Kesem is free to all families.
- CK MIT is sponsored by Kesem National, a 501(c)3 tax-exempt nonprofit organization.
