DESCRIPTION: Enroot provides an intensive intervention program for new immigrant youth. The program will serve 75 to 80 students during SY2016-17. The program includes weekly leadership seminars, academic tutoring, one-on-one mentoring, job readiness training, paid internships, and community service. Enroot program participants are freshman, sophomores, juniors, and seniors enrolled in the English Language Learner (ELL) program at the Cambridge Rindge and Latin School.
