## Scope of Work Inclusive Education Dr. Marilyn Friend 2014-2015

#### Rationale/Purpose:

Twenty-two percent of the students in Cambridge Public Schools (CPSD) are eligible for special education services and meet one of the ten categories of eligibility under Massachusetts's regulations to receive special education services.

The district commissioned an external review of special education that was conducted by West Ed during the 2011-2012 school year, which made specific recommendations regarding special education service delivery, professional development recommendations and decision-making for placement in the least restrictive environment. In addition, due to the reorganization to The Office of Student Services, the district commissioned a review of co-teaching for Haggerty Elementary, the four Upper schools and Cambridge Rindge and Latin School (CRLS).

The co-teaching review included a basic overview of special education services. The review yielded evidence that supported recommendations to improve the overall programs and services for students with disabilities including the development of an aligned protocol for decision-making by IEP teams and specific professional development related to best practices and current practices for inclusive education.

#### **Expected Outcomes:**

- Development of an aligned decision-making protocol
- Development and facilitation of Professional Learning Communities inclusive of general and special education teachers at the Haggerty School, school psychologists and coordinators.
- Development of strategic goals and action steps for the Office of Student Services long-term strategic plan specifically focused on inclusive education.
- Planning with phase-in school(s) regarding inclusive educational environments through classroom observations, teacher/service provider planning sessions and consultation with the principal and OSS leadership.

### Measures/Deliverables:

- Development of the Least Restrictive Environment Protocol
- Completion of the long-term strategic plan with a specific goal and action steps regarding inclusive education
- Survey of principals, special education and general education teachers
- Written feedback/report of school visits, observations and next steps regarding PLC work
