## Description:

Due to the recent increase in enrollment of Immigrant students, the district is now eligible for the Title III Immigrant grant. This grant will fund an after school program for ELLS in grades 9-12 in ESL, math, and science. It will also provide an ESL class for ELL parents at CRLS to strengthen language skills and family engagement, and an after school ELL College and Career Exploration program. The grant will provide for two Assistant Teachers; one in math for SIFE students at CRLS, and the second an ELL Reading tutor for the SEI elementary program. Supplies for the program and 15 registrations for teachers to attend the MATSOL annual conference will also be provided.
