

*Description:* Due to the recent increase in enrollment of Immigrant students, the district is eligible for the Title III Immigrant grant this year. This grant will fund two new five-week summer programs for ELL students in the district (approximately 20 elementary and upper school students in each program), as well as an ESL class for Immigrant parents and a one-week College and Career Exploration program for 11<sup>th</sup> grade ELLs, which will include visits to post-secondary institutions.
