Apple Inc. Contract Remaining JK-5 Staff Devices

Over the past five years, since the completion of the CRLS renovation, we have been striving to develop a sustainable district wide technology replacement plan. Every summer progress has been made to upgrade all classrooms working down towards JK-K. Through this process appropriate classroom technology models were aligned to curricular needs at each grade span. Last summer, 2014, we were able to complete the upgrade of all student devices and most teacher devices. The remaining JK-5 specialist staff are the last group of staff requiring technology upgrades to complete our JK-12 replacement cycle.

This contract with Apple, Inc. will cover replacement devices (desktop or laptop computers as identified appropriate) for specialist positions in the JK-5 schools, including, but not limited to VPA, PE, OSS, Bilingual teachers and Library Media Specialists. These purchases will complete our efforts to establish a sustainable six-year replacement cycle of all teacher and student devices.
