

Integration Partners Switch Purchase

This purchase of network switches is intended for the Haggerty, Cambridgeport and Graham & Parks schools. These switches are considered a routine network maintenance/upgrade. Every year a portion of the CPS network infrastructure is upgraded to ensure the entire infrastructure is maintained in good working order and there are no weak links in the network.

The installation of these switches will complete the installation of full 1GB switched ports to all classrooms and locations throughout the district. These switches will also enable the upgrade of the district's WAN backbone to a full 10GB speed between these schools and the network operations center located at CRLS.

Due to a change in Erate funding program CPS is now eligible for Erate reimbursement on some internal networking equipment. As a result CPS will receive a 60% discount on this purchase. CPS out of pocket expense will be \$22,184.
