

## **Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center**

Once you locate an article, click on the *Source Citation* tab, copy and paste the publisher's citation into your document. Edit it into the citation style for your assignment. These examples are presented in MLA, 7<sup>th</sup> ed. (2009) style.

### **Include these items to cite a periodical publication in an online database in MLA, 7<sup>th</sup> ed. (2009)**

1. Author's complete name: Last name, first name initial or middle name.
2. Article title: Enclose the title with quotation marks.
3. Journal title: Italicize and no period at the end
4. Volume number: Do not use the word volume or its abbreviation. Provide the volume number followed by a period.
5. Issue number: Follows the previous period and do not end with a period.
6. Year of publication: in parenthesis followed by a colon and a space
7. Inclusive pages: n. pag. is used if inclusive page numbers are not available.
8. Title of the database: italicize.
9. Medium of publication: Web.
10. Date of access: day month year.
