### **Guidelines for making Parenthetical References:**

- Use the author's last name, if there is one. Use the first few words of the article's title, if there is no author listed. In either case, it should be the first word or words in the citation.
- Put the reference information in parentheses at the end of the sentence or below the visual image.

### **Guidelines for making a Works Cited page:**

- List the citations in alphabetical order by the first word.
- Indent all lines after the first line of each citation. This is called a 'hanging' paragraph.
- Double space the entire list with no extra spaces between citations.
- Title it Works Cited in the same size and font as the rest of the page.
