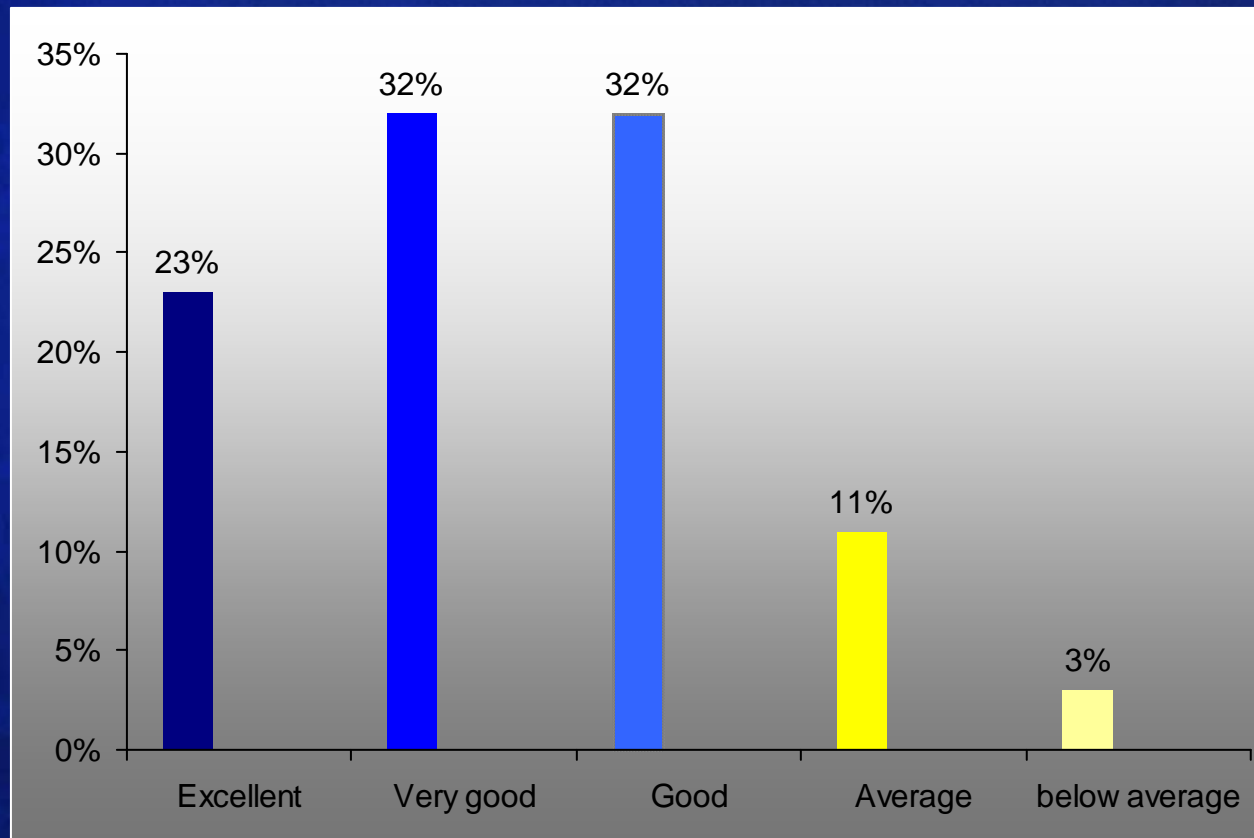

# Survey details

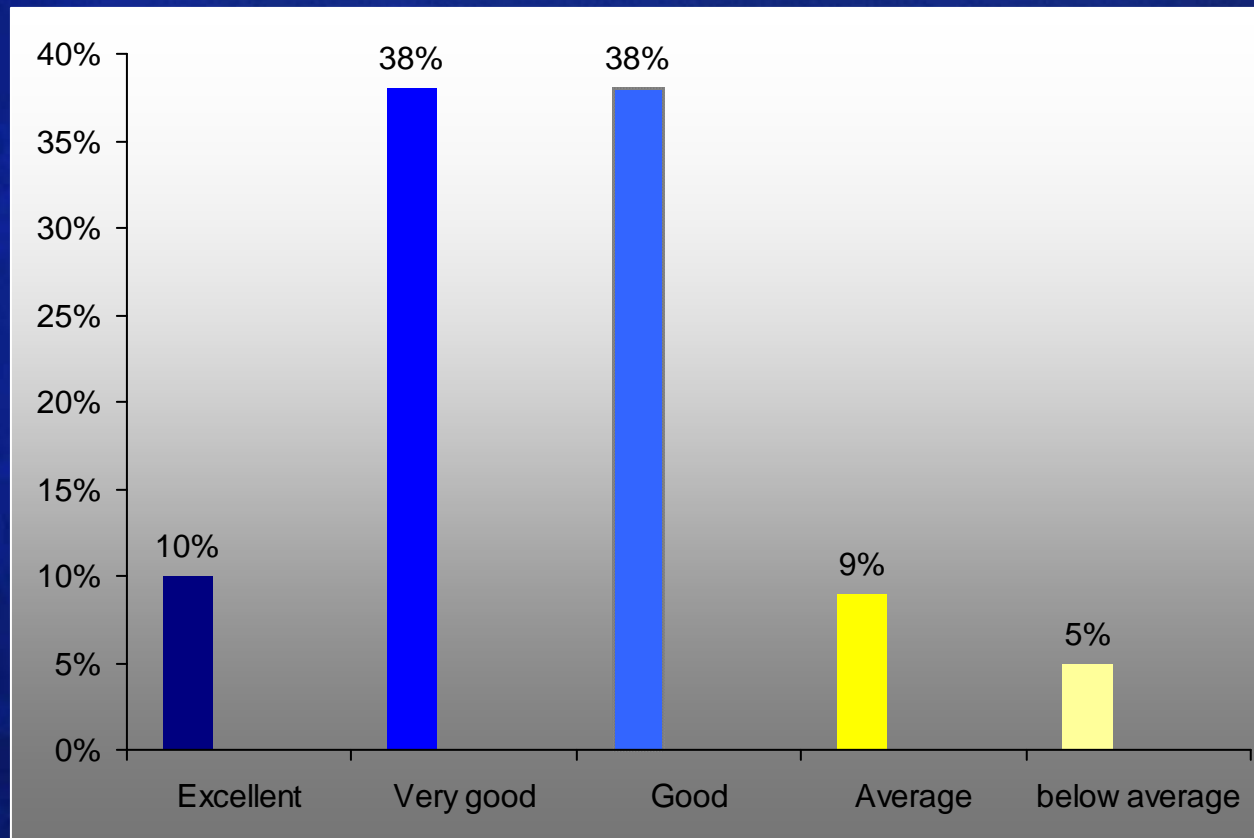
186 CRLS seniors surveyed randomly and anonymously on Friday, May 8 and Monday, May 11, 2009.

Results were tabulated via Scantron computer.

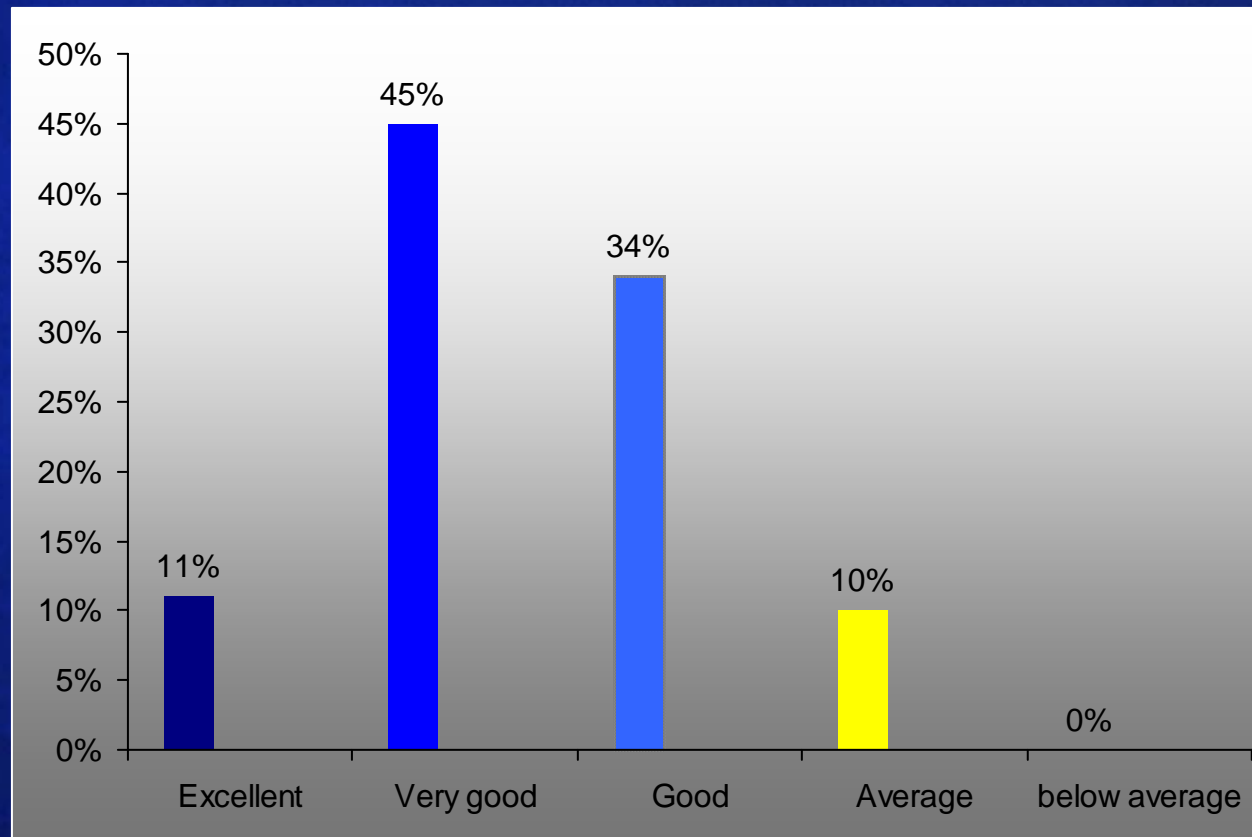
# How would you describe your overall CRLS experience?



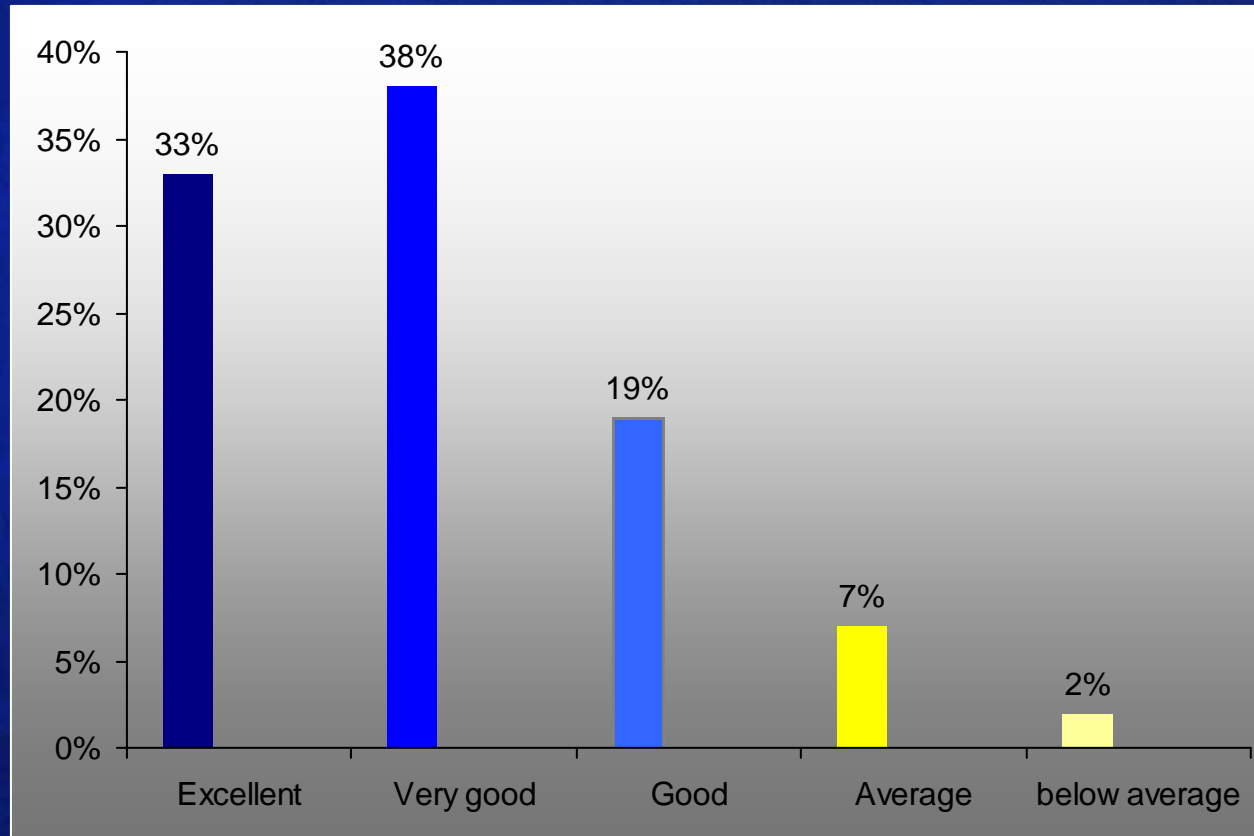
# How well did CRLS prepare you for life after high school?



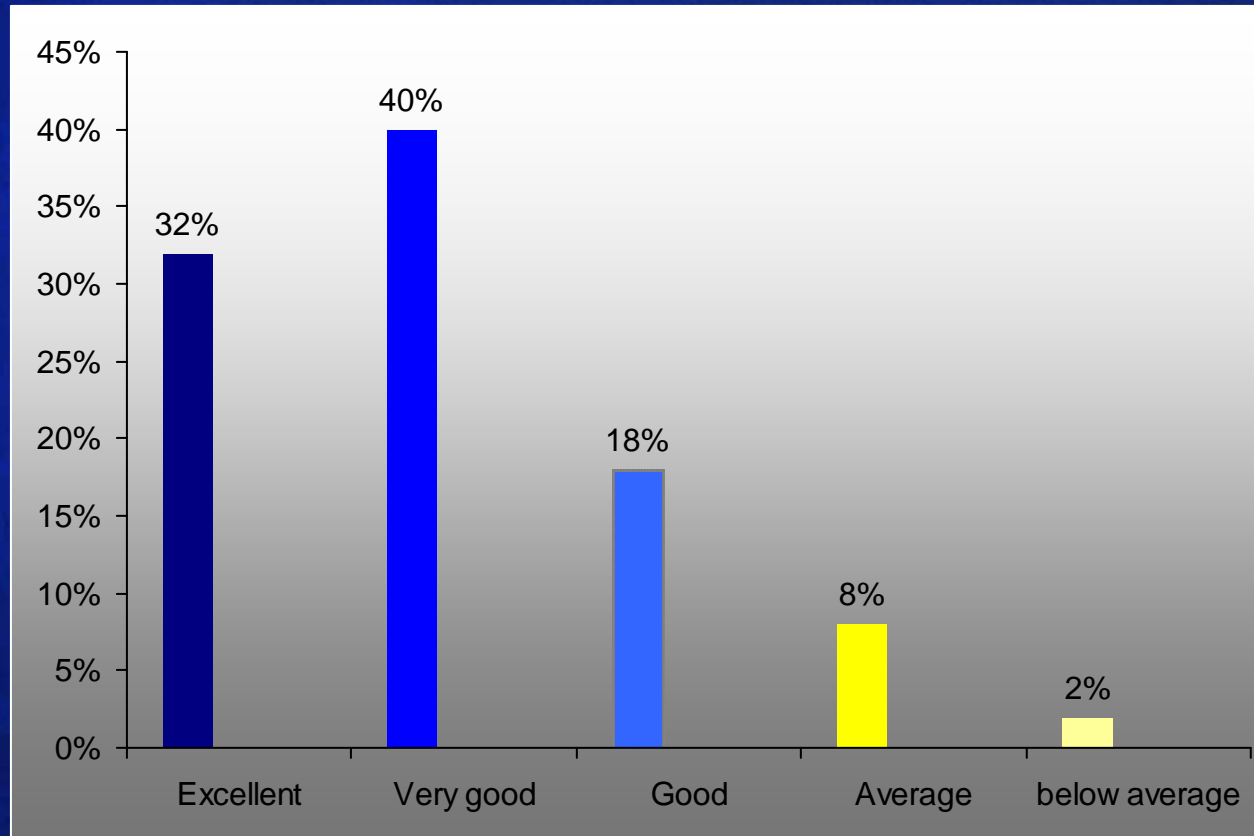
# How would you rate the overall quality of the teaching staff at CRLS?



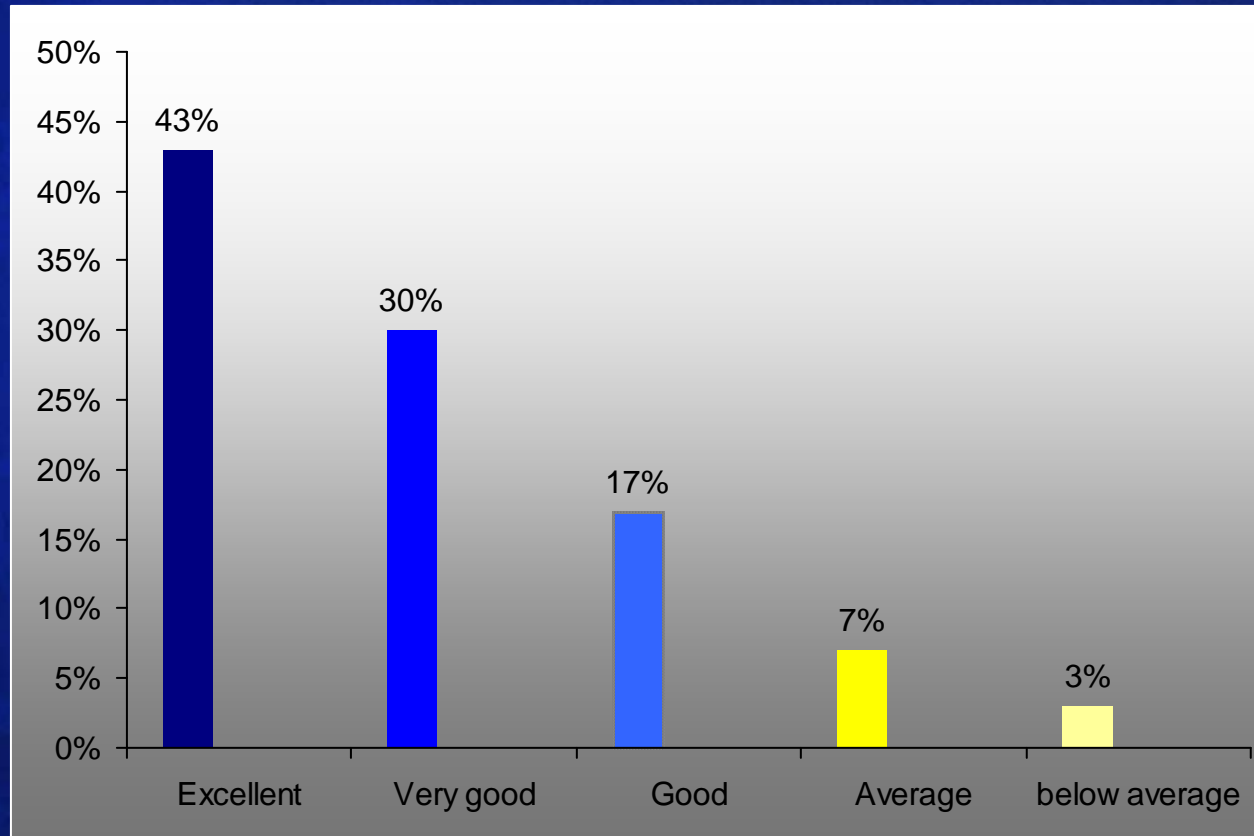
# How would you rate the academic offerings?



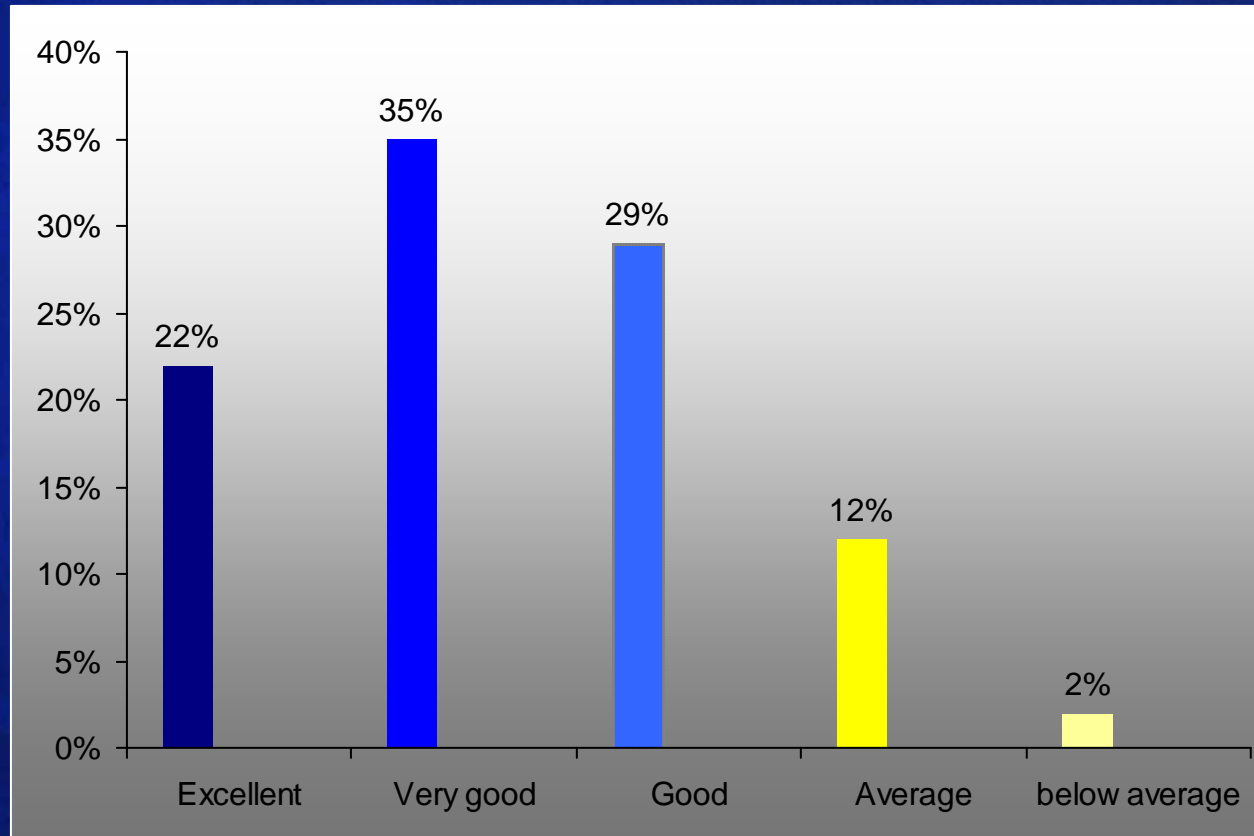
# How would you rate the athletic offerings?



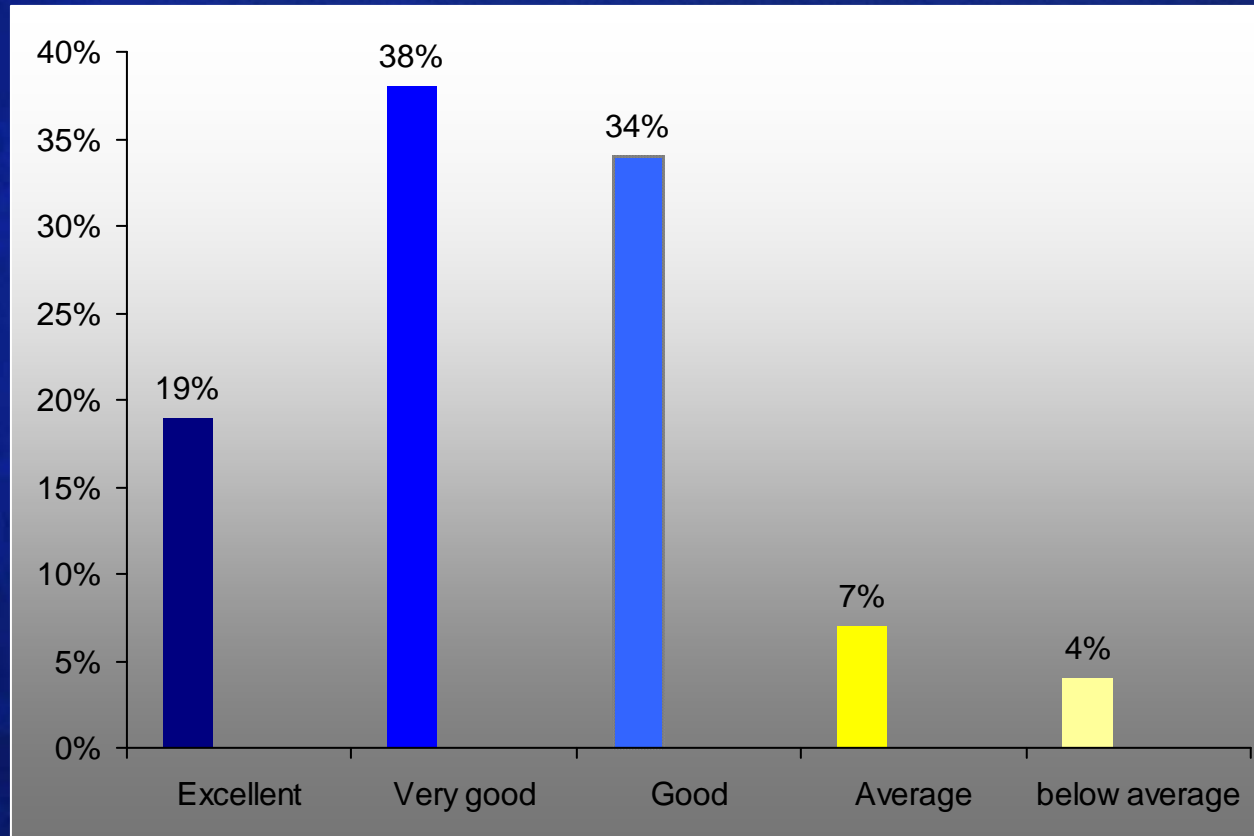
# How would you rate the artistic options at CRLS?



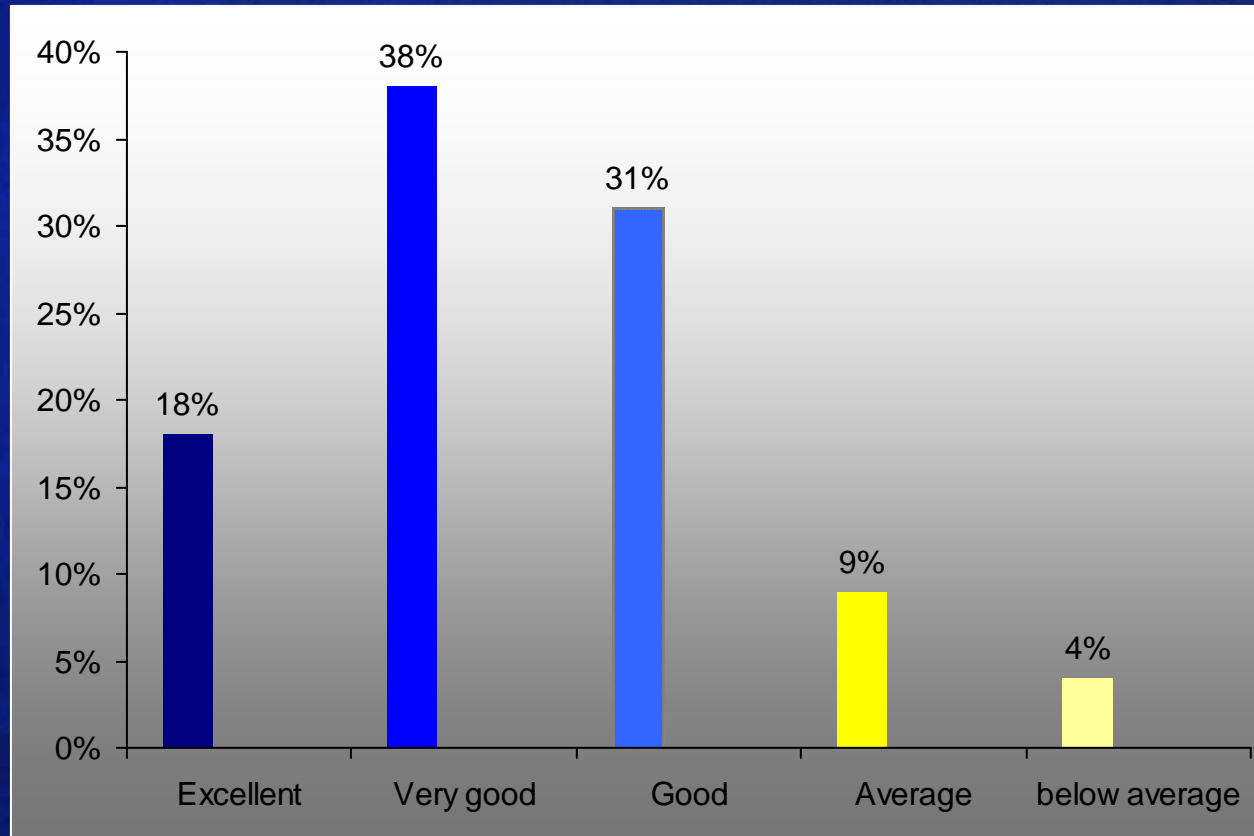
# How would you rate the academic clubs and other after school options at CRLS?



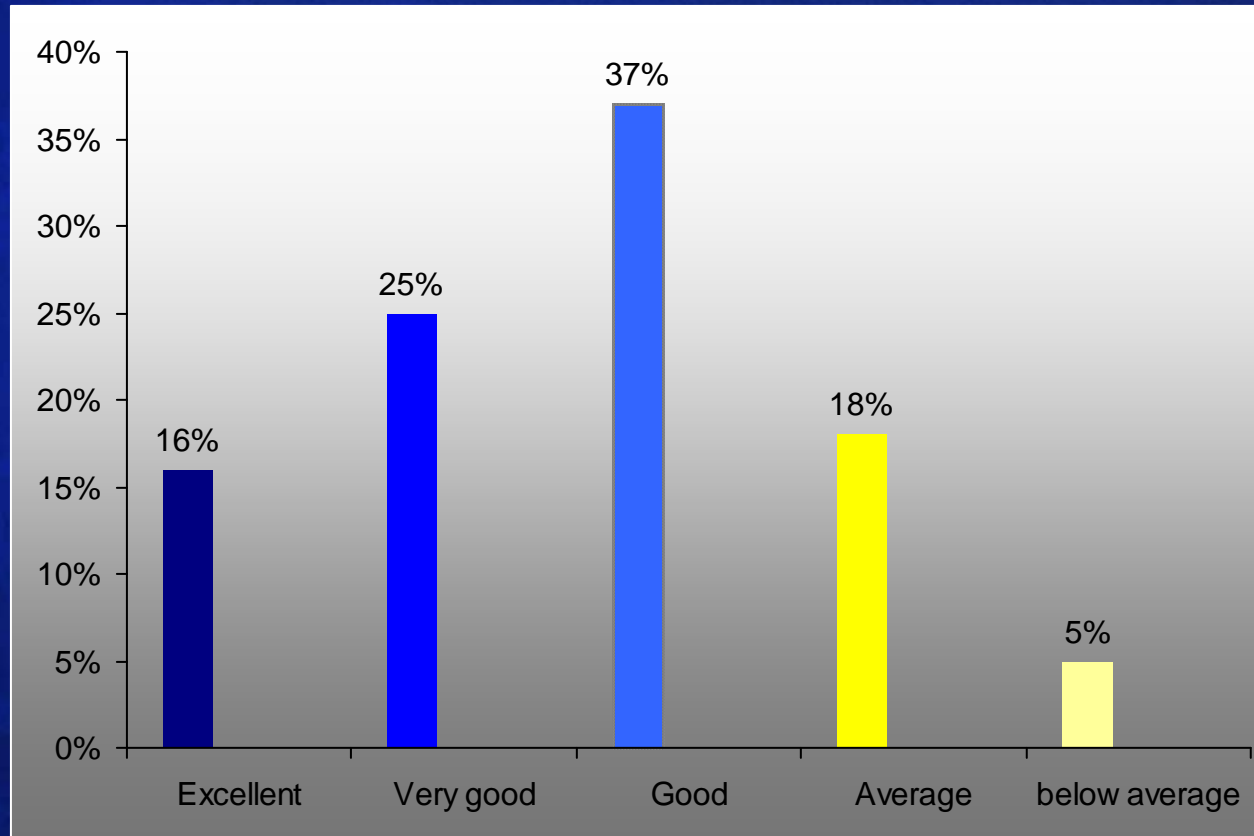

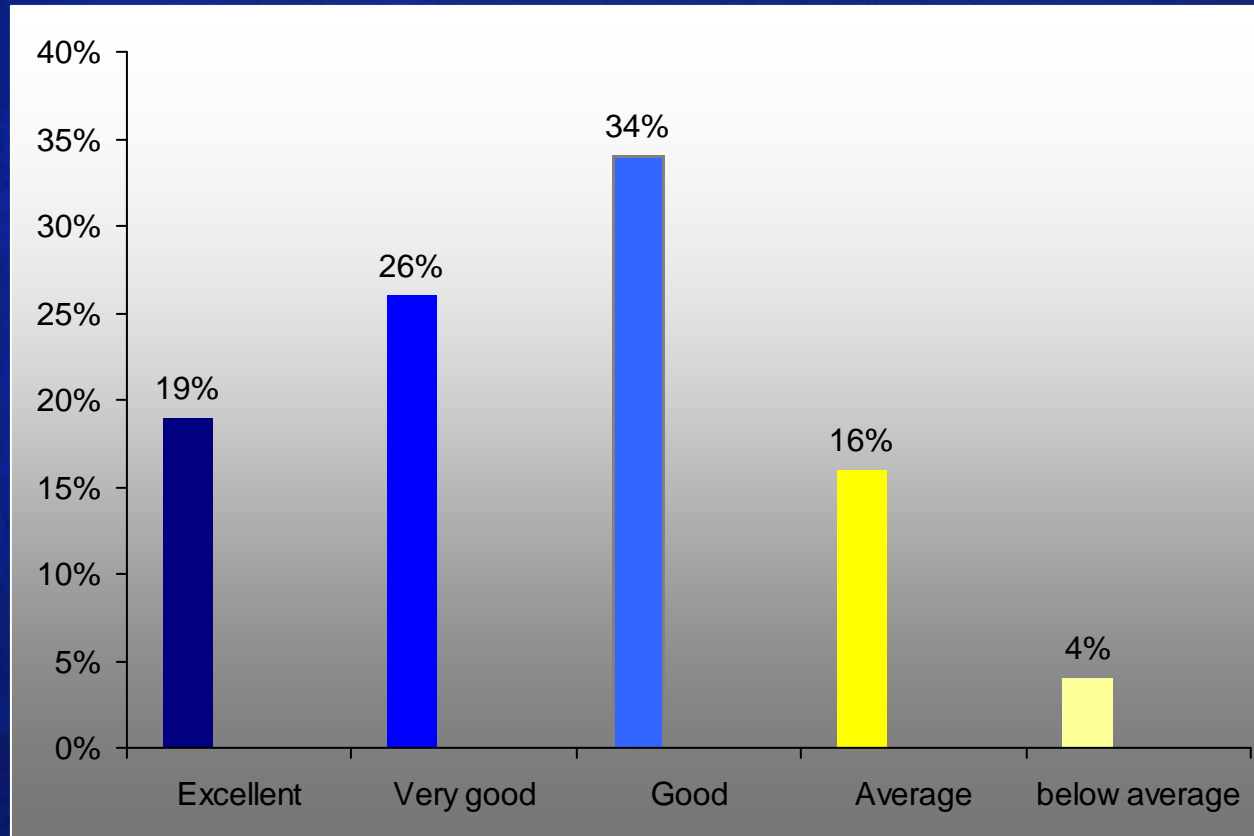

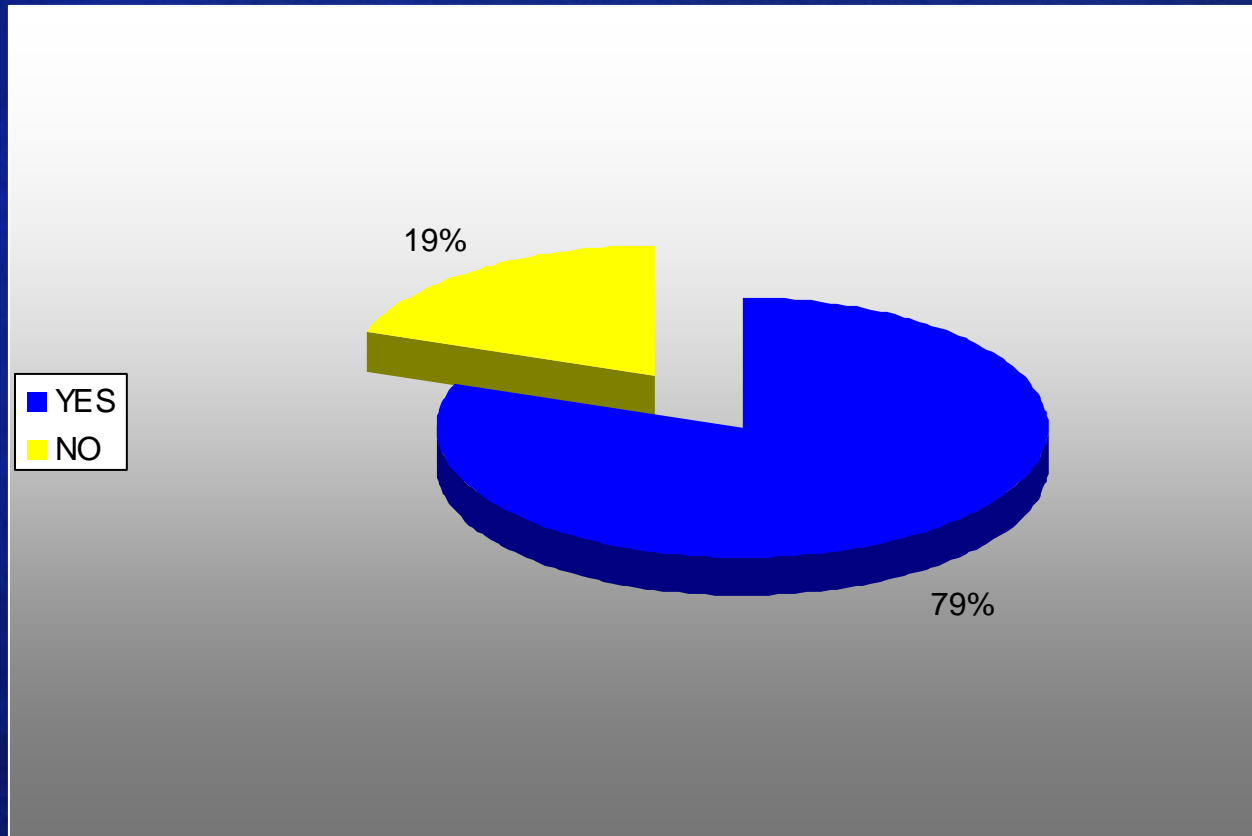

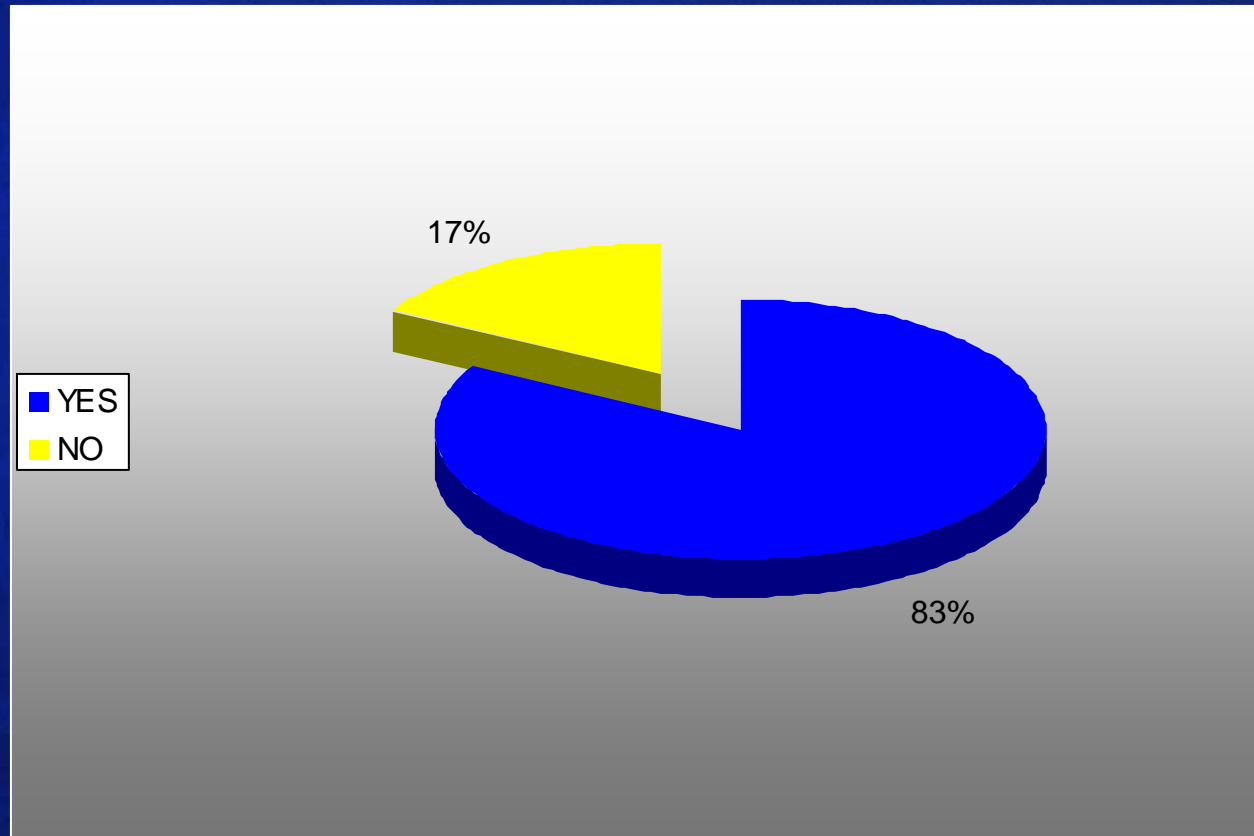

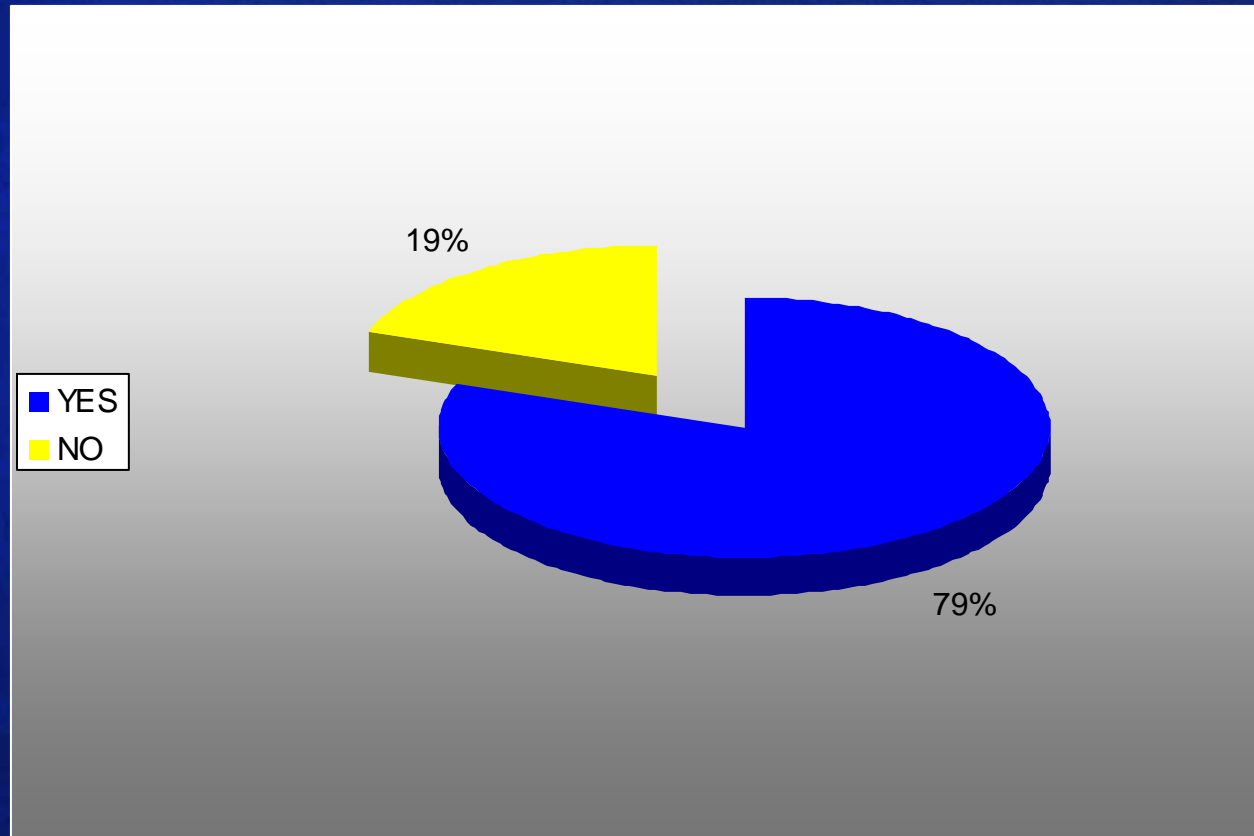

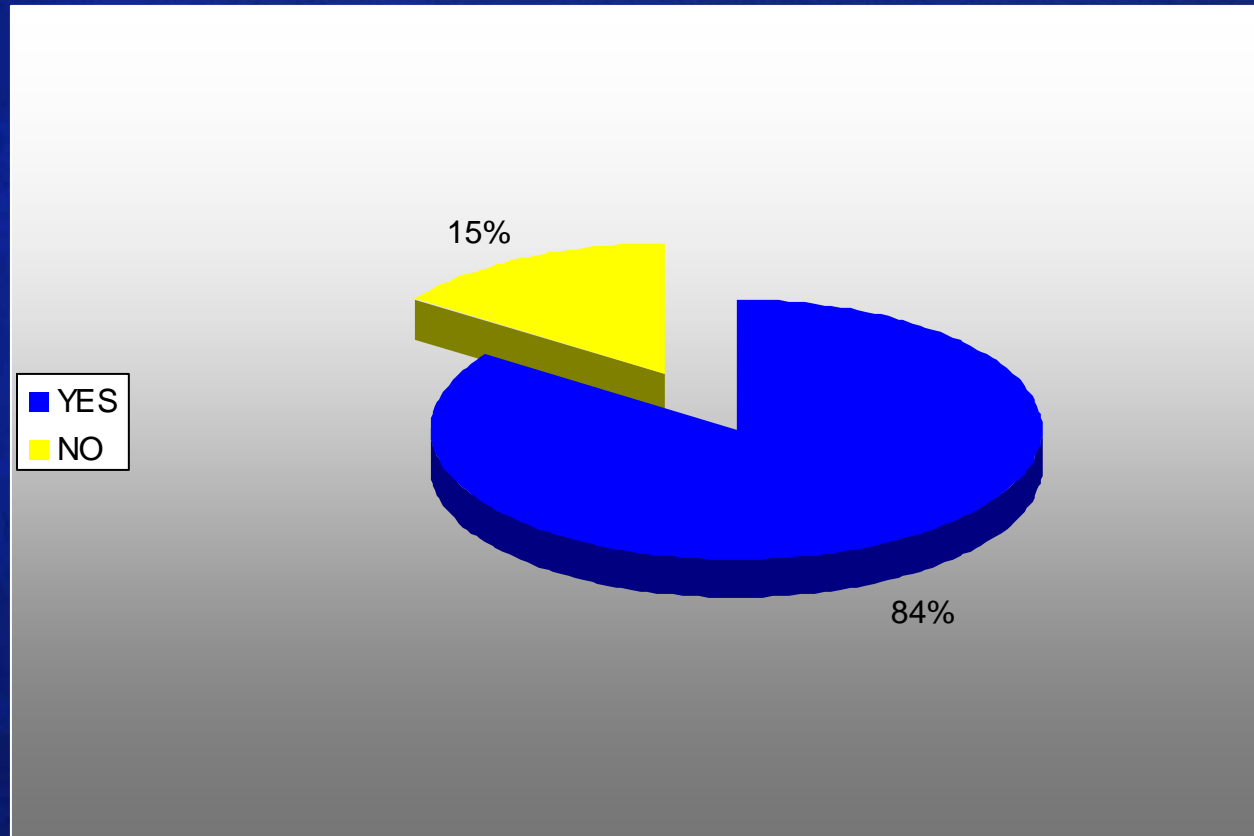

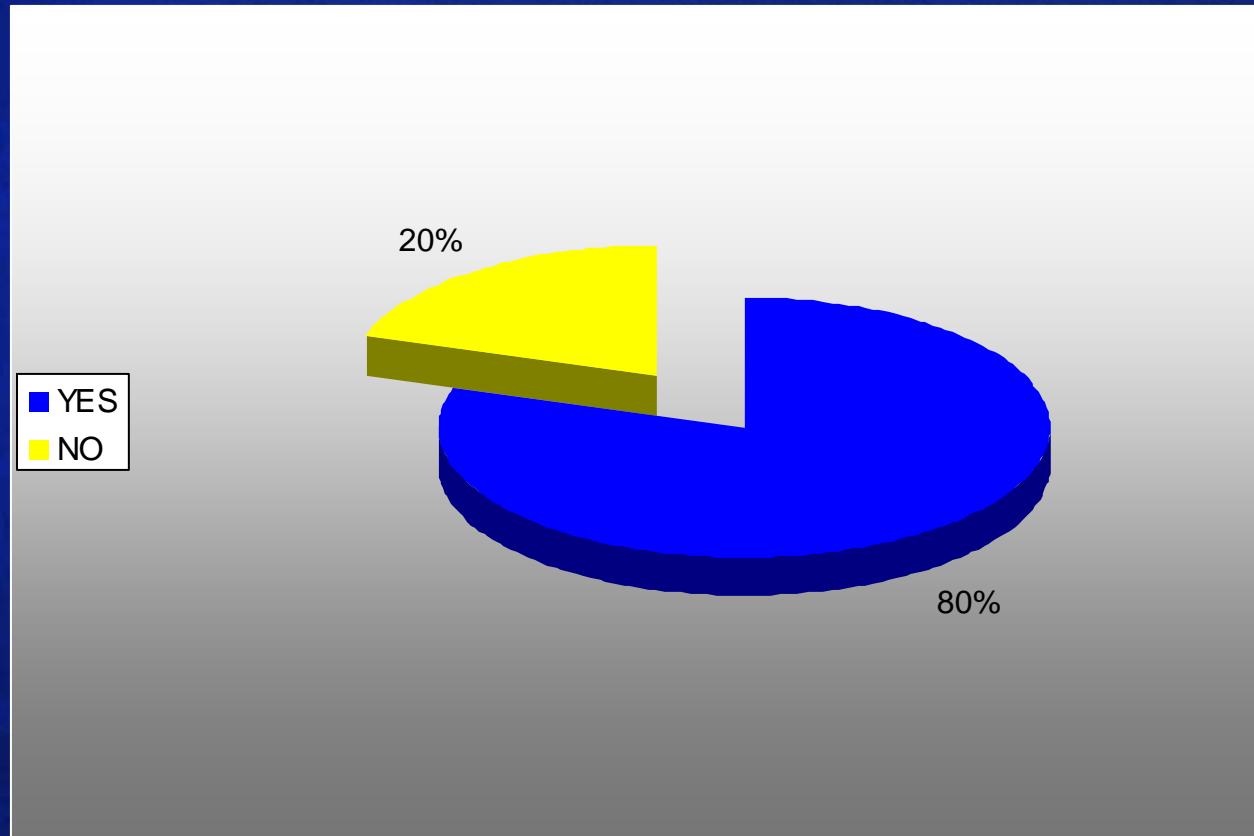

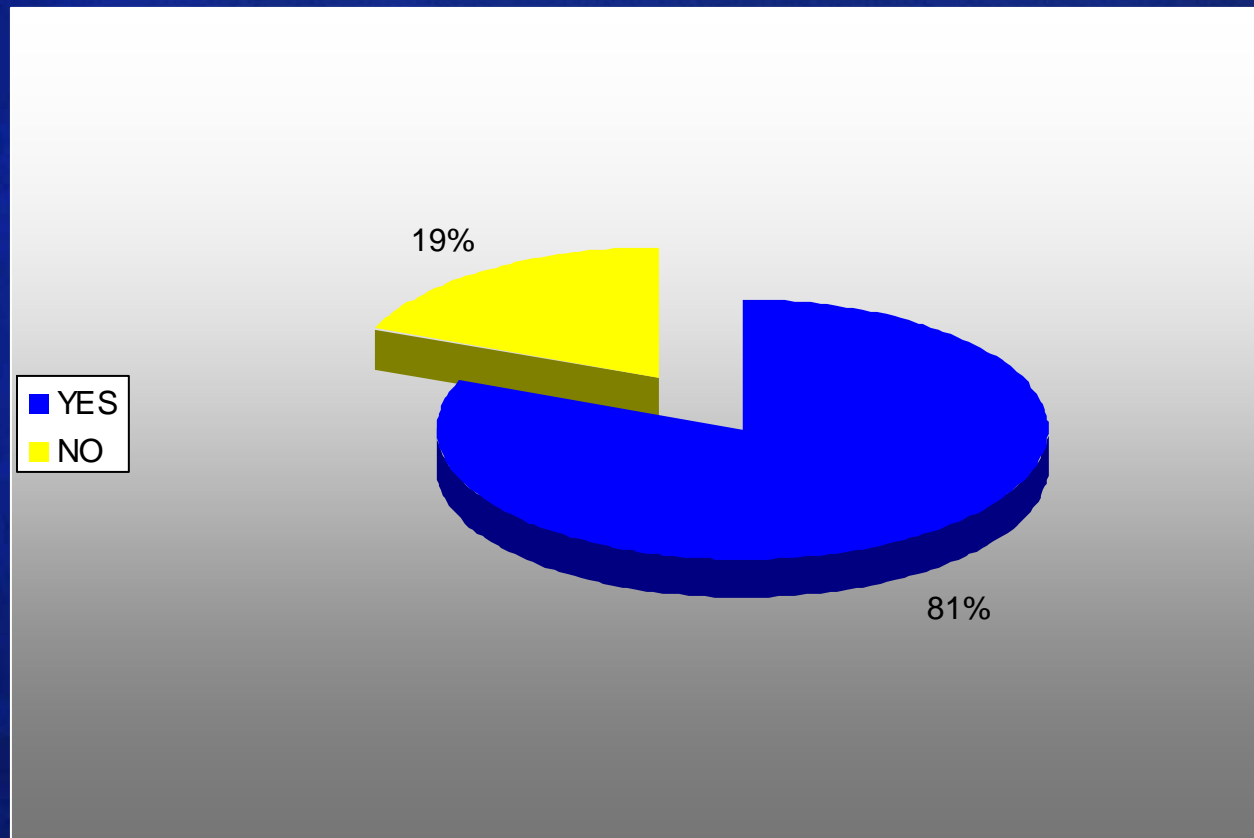

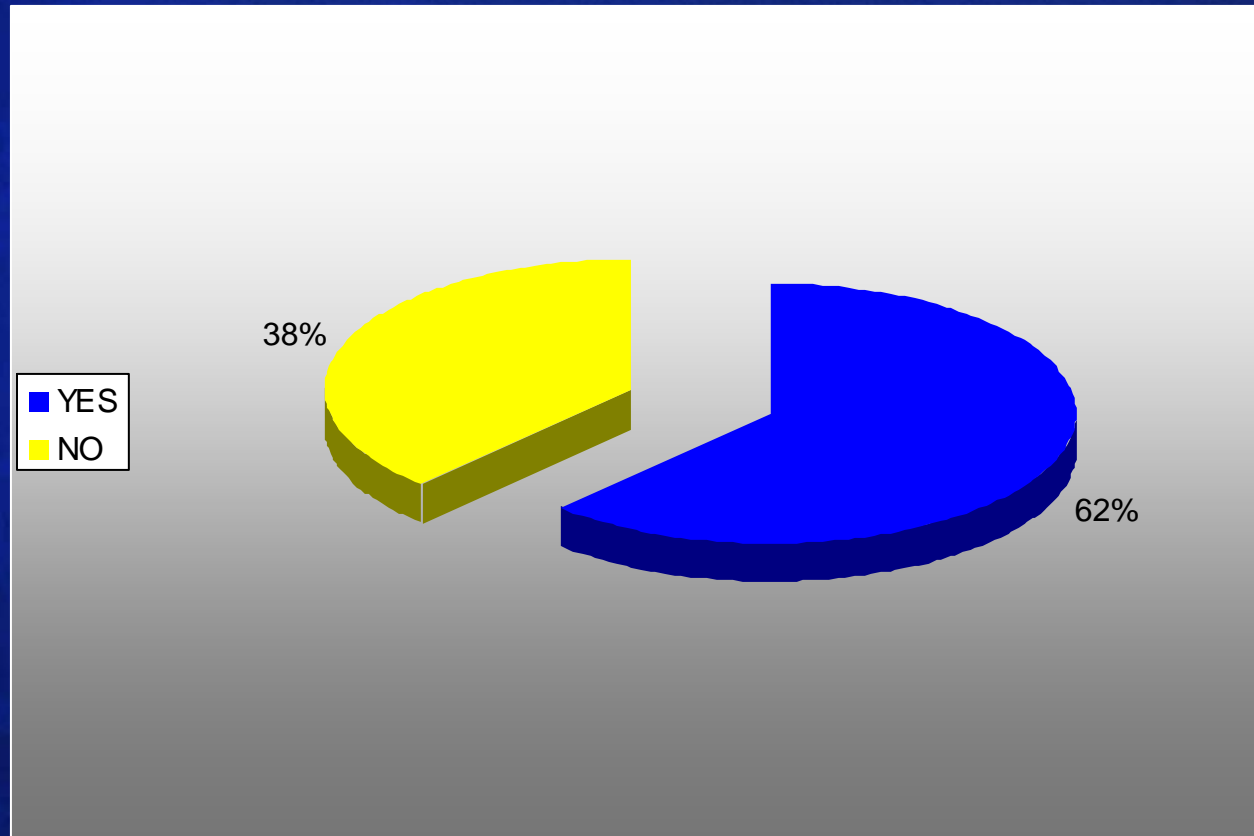
# Does CRLS do a good job helping students succeed?
