

GRADING SYSTEMS HIGH SCHOOLS

Cambridge Rindge and Latin School (“CRLS”) issues letter grades based on a numerical scale of 0 to 100. The minimum passing grade is 60, while the minimum honors grade is 80.

The school year consists of four "quarters" or grading periods; report cards are issued at the end of each period. Warning notices are sent to the parents/guardians of all students who are in danger of failing at the middle of each quarter. To determine whether a student passes or fails a course, his grade shall be averaged for the year (four quarters) or half-year (two quarters), depending on whether the course is a semester or a full-year course.

To make up a failing grade, a student may attend summer school or repeat the course during the school year.
