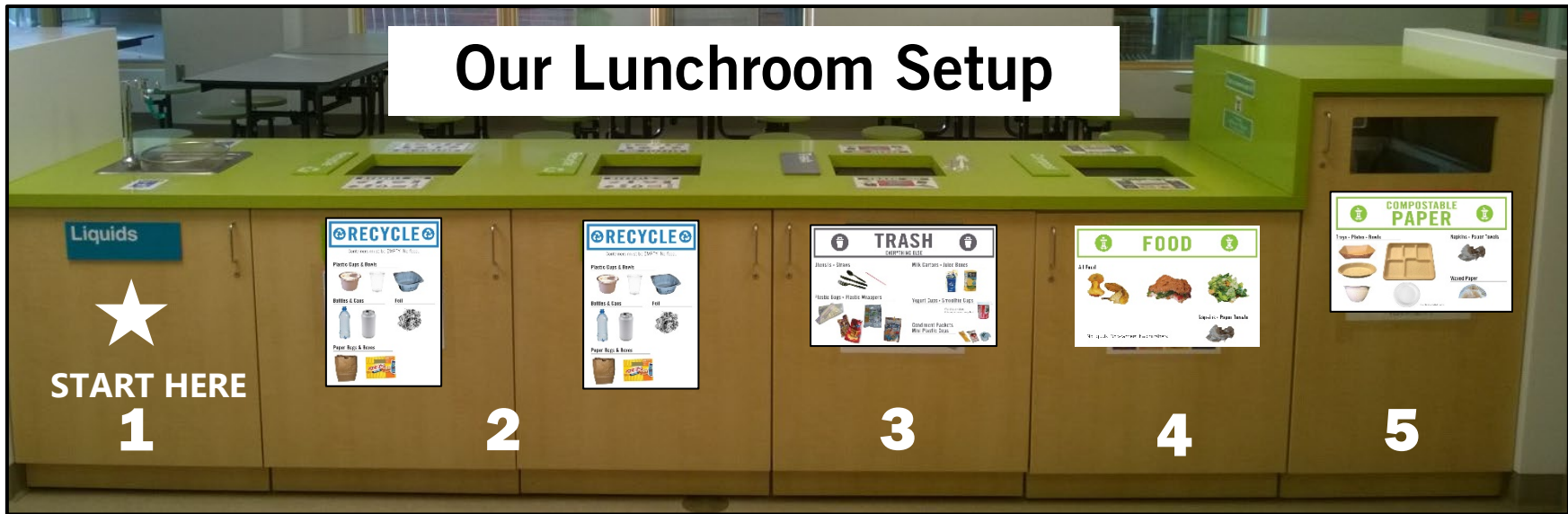


# Our Lunchroom Setup

## Tips to Help You “Get Rid of It Right”

# Get Ready to Clean Up!

While still at your seat:

**DRINK IT,  
OPEN IT**

- Try to finish your drink.
- If there’s drink left, make the opening bigger so it pours out faster.

**UNWRAP FOOD,  
SHAKE FOIL**

- Take food out of wrappers.  
\*Unopened food that was bought at school:  
> put on Share Table
- Shake foil to get off as much food as you can. Foil goes in RECYCLE unless there’s a lot of food on it.

**PILE TRASH**

- Pile together all utensils, straws, plastic wrappers, mini cups, etc.
- Then you can grab it all at once and put it in the trash.
