# CRLS ZONE MAP

## How To Read CRLS Room Numbers

The new CRLS new room numbers are 4 digits long.

- ▶ The first digit is the floor that the room is on.
- ▶ The second digit is the zone that the room is in
- ▶ The last two digits are the room numbers that move along the corridors sequentially.

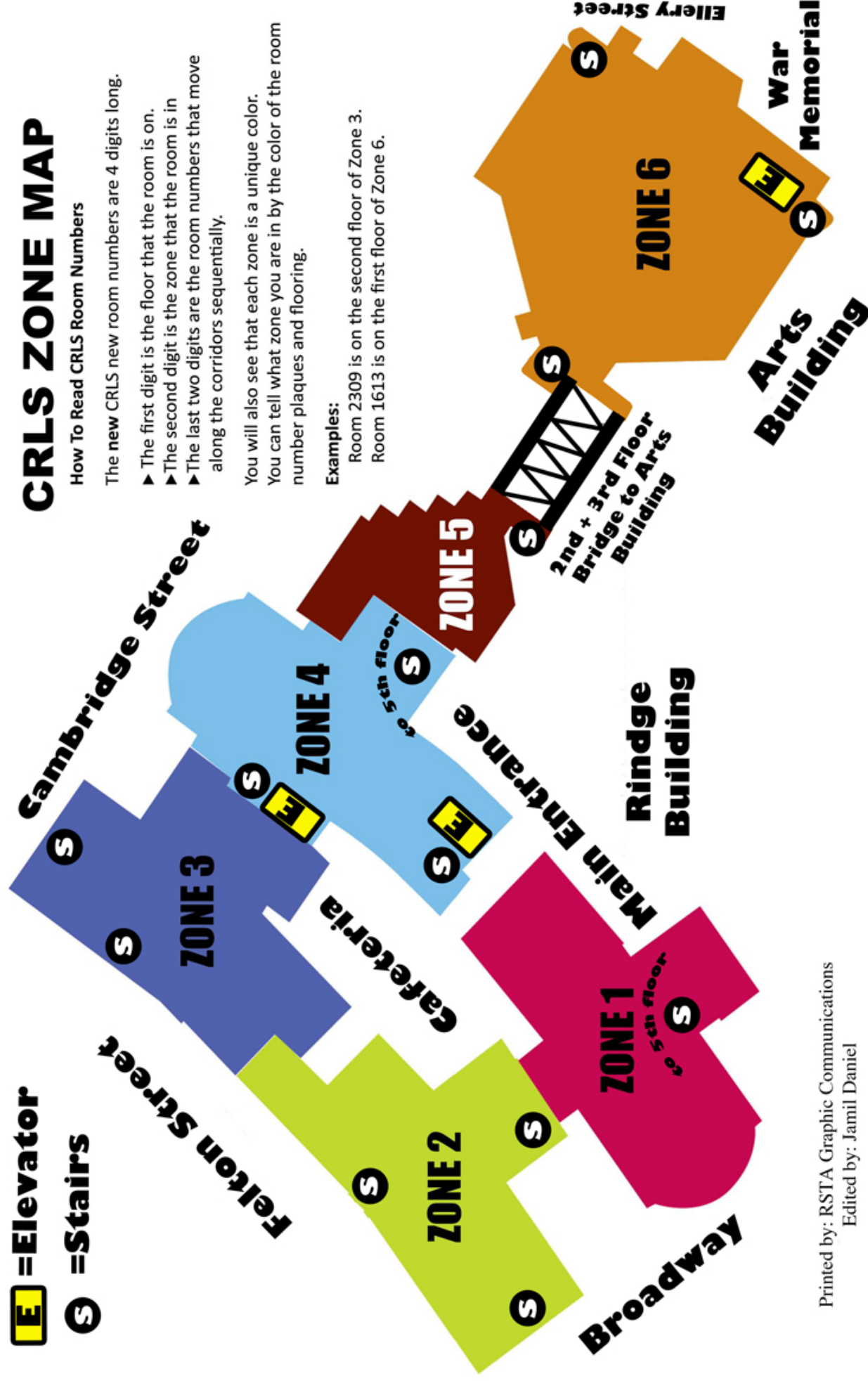
You will also see that each zone is a unique color.

You can tell what zone you are in by the color of the room number plaques and flooring.

## Examples:

Room 2309 is on the second floor of Zone 3.

Room 1613 is on the first floor of Zone 6.
