## SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: FY20-21 Ed Tech HiQ Contract



**Purpose:** To provide hardware to schools and departments. To ensure timely processing and delivery, it is beneficial to have an open contract in place for the start of the fiscal year.

**Amount of Contract:** \$550,000

# **Description/Scope of Services:**

<u>Grades 2/3 Student Devices</u> - As part of the educational technology replacement plan, all grades 2 and 3 classrooms will receive new Chromebooks in class sets for each core classroom, plus additional devices to support special programs. This totals \$200,000.

<u>CRLS Freshman Chromebooks</u> - As part of the CRLS Connects 1:1 initiative, each Freshman student receives a Chromebook. This totals \$150,000.

<u>Elementary Carts</u> - To store, charge, and secure class sets of Chromebooks for each core classroom in the elementary schools (excluding MLK and King Open), approximately 60 carts will be purchased. This totals \$75,000.

<u>Chromebook Replacements & Parts</u> - In order to be flexible and responsive to any device replacements and repairs as a result of Chromebooks being at home with students in grades JK-12. These needs are estimated at \$75,000.

<u>Misc School Purchases</u> - Schools and departments typically purchase hardware and accessories for their various programs. These miscellaneous purchases are estimated at \$50,000.
